The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1. The date of priority is 1876.

The right is limited to not more than 1.748 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 15, T 39 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 1080 FEET SOUTH AND 1600 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 15.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCTOBER 8, 1984, and together with certificate 52560, supersedes certificate 51731, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
