confirms the right to use the waters of EAST FORK DAIRY CREEK, a tributary of DAIRY CREEK, for the purpose of NURSERY USE ON 4.0 ACRES DURING THE PERIOD MAY 1 TO SEPTEMBER 30.

The right has been perfected under Permit 30742. The date of priority is JANUARY 17, 1966. The right is limited to not more than 0.05 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 16, T 2 N, R 3 W, W.M.; 150 FEET NORTH AND 1290 FEET WEST FROM THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 16.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4 4.0 ACRES SECTION 16 TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JANUARY 19, 1982, and together with certificate 50931, supersedes certificate 37355, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
