## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

H. M. BUTLER REDMOND, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of SQUAW CREEK, a tributary of DESCHUTES RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 15.7 ACRES.

The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for CROOK County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 1, at page 471. The date of priority is 1901.

The right is limited to not more than 0.314 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

McCallister Ditch; SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 29, T 15 S, R 10 E, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FIFTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4 15.2 ACRES SW 1/4 SE 1/4 0.5 ACRE SECTION 7 TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 975, Volume 2, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on OCTOBER 20, 1989.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
