CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ASPEN VALLEY RANCH
POST, OREGON 97752

confirms the right to use the waters of THE CROOKED RIVER, a tributary of the DESCHUTES RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 90.0 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 3003. The date of priority is JULY 8, 1916. The right is limited to not more than 1.13 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 34, T 16 S, R 19 E, W.M.; 2100 FEET SOUTH AND 10 FEET WEST; 2200 FEET SOUTH AND 10 FEET WEST, BOTH FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 34.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4	16.0 ACRES
NW 1/4 NE 1/4	25.0 ACRES
SW 1/4 NE 1/4	17.0 ACRES
SE 1/4 NE 1/4	32.0 ACRES
SECTION 34	
TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 19 EAST, W.M.	

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEPTEMBER 22, 1977, and supersedes certificate 3708, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
