CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO UNNAMED SPRINGS tributaries of JACK CREEK, for the purpose of LIVESTOCK.

The right has been perfected under Permit 48630. The date of priority is APRIL 4, 1983. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND; BEING 0.005 CFS FROM EACH SPRING or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SPRING 1 - SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 24, T 26 S, R 9 E, W.M.; 790 FEET NORTH AND 2770 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER OF SECTION 24.

SPRING 2 - SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 1, T 27 S, R 9 E, W.M.; 2240 FEET SOUTH AND 1120 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER OF SECTION 1.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4
SECTION 24
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 9 EAST, W.M.

SE 1/4 NE 1/4
SECTION 1
TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 9 EAST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
