CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of RAVEN SPRING a tributary of
THREEMILE CREEK, for the purpose of LIVESTOCK AND WILDLIFE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 48729. The date of priority
is NOVEMBER 4, 1981. The right is limited to not more than 0.004 CUBIC
FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the
point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 32, T 3 S, R 11 E, W.M.; 1110 FEET SOUTH AND
1320 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER OF SECTION 32.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be
ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such
right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4
SECTION 32
TOWNSHIP 3 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to
beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is
subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission
with an effective date prior to this right.
