CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of DOLLIE SPRING a tributary of BUCK CREEK, for the purpose of LIVESTOCK.

The right has been perfected under Permit 48989. The date of priority is JUNE 9, 1983. The right is limited to not more than 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 3, T 37 S, R 11 1/2 E, W.M.; 2240 FEET NORTH AND 960 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER OF SECTION 3.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4
SECTION 3
TOWNSHIP 37 SOUTH, RANGE 11 1/2 EAST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
