CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of RINGER SPRING a tributary of FOURMILE CREEK, for the purpose of WILDLIFE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 49174. The date of priority is OCTOBER 31, 1984. The right is limited to not more than 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 26, T 36 S, R 5 E, W.M.; 400 FEET SOUTH AND 2400 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER OF SECTION 26.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4
SECTION 26
TOWNSHIP 36 SOUTH, RANGE 5 EAST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
