CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of CORRAL SPRING a tributary of WILLIAMSON RIVER, for the purpose of LIVESTOCK.

The right has been perfected under Permit 49215. The date of priority is AUGUST 19, 1983. The right is limited to not more than 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 23, T 31 S, R 9 E, W.M.; 1400 FEET SOUTH AND 1450 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER OF SECTION 23.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4  
SECTION 23  
TOWNSHIP 31 SOUTH, RANGE 9 EAST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
