CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of DEADMAN SPRING a tributary of MCKAY CREEK, for the purpose of LIVESTOCK.

The right has been perfected under Permit 49588. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 13, 1985. The right is limited to not more than 0.001 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 29, T 12 S, R 17 E, W.M.; 1892 FEET NORTH AND 1980 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER OF SECTION 29.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4
SECTION 29
TOWNSHIP 12 SOUTH, RANGE 17 EAST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
