CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A SUMP in the DEER CREEK BASIN for the purpose of IRRIGATING 80.0 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit G-9806. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 15, 1981. The right is limited to not more than 1.0 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the sump.

The sump is located as follows:

LOT 1 (NW 1/4 NE 1/4), SECTION 18, T 38 S, R 7 W, W.M.; 2480 FEET NORTH AND 380 FEET EAST FROM THE CENTER 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 18.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

LOT 1 (NW 1/4 NE 1/4) 30.0 ACRES
LOT 2 (SW 1/4 NE 1/4) 30.6 ACRES
LOT 3 (NW 1/4 SE 1/4) 19.4 ACRES
SECTION 18
TOWNSHIP 38 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
