confirms the right to use the waters of WELLS #1 AND #2 in the ANTELOPE CREEK BASIN for the purpose of QUASI-MUNICIPAL USE.

The right has been perfected under Permit G-9763. The date of priority is MARCH 17, 1982. The right is limited to not more than 37.0 GALLONS PER MINUTE; BEING 30.0 GPM FROM WELL #1 AND 7.0 GPM FROM WELL #2 or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 30, T 7 S, R 17 E, W.M.; WELL #1 - 1380 FEET NORTH AND 1398 FEET WEST; WELL #2 - 124 FEET NORTH AND 958 FEET WEST; BOTH FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 30.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 17 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
