CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ROBERT AND DONNA DELIKAT
19509 N.E. WOODLAND LOOP ROAD
YAMHILL, OREGON 97148

confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING, a tributary of STAG HOLLOW CREEK, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE OF NONCOMMERCIAL LAWN AND GARDEN AND STOCK WATER.

The right has been perfected under Permit 35553. The date of priority is AUGUST 13, 1970, FOR DOMESTIC AND MARCH 22, 1971, FOR STOCK. The right is limited to not more than 0.012 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.008 CFS FOR DOMESTIC AND 0.004 CFS FOR STOCK, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 2 (NE 1/4 SW 1/4), SECTION 36, T 2 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 2100 FEET NORTH AND 150 FEET WEST FROM THE S 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

LOT 2 (NE 1/4 SW 1/4)
SECTION 36
TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
