CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING, a tributary of TUALATIN RIVER, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING IRRIGATION OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE LAWN AND NON-COMMERCIAL GARDEN.

The right has been perfected under Permit 44959. The date of priority is MARCH 11, 1980. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 38, SECTION 25, T 1 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 920 FEET SOUTH AND 2650 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF DLC 38.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 38
SECTION 25
TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

NO WATER SHALL BE APPROPRIATED DURING THE PERIOD JULY 31 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 15 EXCEPT FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
