confirms the right to use the waters of HEATHER SPRING, a tributary of MILLER CREEK, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR DIGIT POINT CAMPGROUND.

The right has been perfected under Permit 48625. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 24, 1983. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 14, T 27 S, R 6 1/2 E, W.M.; 260 FEET SOUTH AND 2150 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER SECTION 14.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
