CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the DESCHUTES RIVER BASIN for the purpose of POTABLE WATER SUPPLY FOR LAVA LAKE RESORT.

The right has been perfected under Permit G-10001. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 30, 1982. The right is limited to not more than 0.08 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 21, T 19 S, R 8 E, W.M.; 2175 FEET NORTH AND 90 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 21.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4
SECTION 21

NW 1/4 SW 1/4
SECTION 22

TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 8 EAST, W.M.

USE OF WATER UNDER THIS RIGHT IS LIMITED TO THE EXTENT THAT SUCH USE DOES NOT REDUCE THE FLOW OF THE DESCHUTES RIVER. ANY REDUCTION WILL REQUIRE THE WELL TO BE REGULATED.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
