CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of the APPLGATE RIVER, a tributary of the ROGUE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 34.0 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 4962. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 28, 1921. The right is limited to not more than 0.43 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 22, NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 27, T 39 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 1420 FEET NORTH AND 1280 FEET EAST; 660 FEET SOUTH AND 960 FEET EAST; BOTH FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 22.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUNE 29, 1983, and supersedes certificate 5298, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
