CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of the APPLGATE RIVER, a tributary of the ROGUE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 5.0 ACRES AND LIVESTOCK.

The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1. The date of priority is 1876.

The right is limited to not more than 0.125 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 22, T 39 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 1420 FEET NORTH AND 1280 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 22.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 1.0 ACRE
NW 1/4 SW 1/4 4.0 ACRES
SECTION 22
TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUNE 29, 1983, and together with certificate 51731, supersedes certificate 50339, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
