The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1. The date of priority is 1857.

The right is limited to not more than 0.06 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 2 (SE 1/4 NW 1/4), SECTION 34, T 38 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 90 FEET SOUTH AND 1100 FEET WEST FROM THE NW CORNER OF DLC 67.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4 5.0 ACRES SECTION 34 TOWNSHIP 38 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JULY 20, 1983, and together with certificate 52561, supersedes certificate 16081, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
