## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of the SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of the UMPQUA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 3.0 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 7528. The date of priority is AUGUST 20, 1926. The right is limited to not more than 0.0375 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 39, SECTION 12, T 29 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 2890 FEET NORTH AND 3180 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 12.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4 3.0 ACRES
SECTION 12
TOWNSHIP 29 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUNE 8, 1982, and together with certificates 51323, 64184, 64182, 64181, 64180, 64179, and the special order of May 6, 1985, supersedes certificate 8794, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
