confirms the right to use the waters of INDIAN CREEK, a tributary of the JOHN DAY RIVER, in the JOHN DAY BASIN to maintain an instream flow for the purpose of ANADROMOUS AND RESIDENT FISH HABITAT AND RECREATIONAL FISHING.

The right is for flows to be maintained IN INDIAN CREEK FROM THE MOUTH OF OVERHOLT CREEK AT RIVER MILE 7.0 (SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 10, T 14 S, R 33 E, W.M.); TO THE MOUTH OF LITTLE INDIAN CREEK AT RIVER MILE 2.0 (SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 19, T 13 S, R 33 E, W.M.).

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.341.

The date of priority is JUNE 12, 1989.

The right is limited to not more than the amounts during the time periods listed below:
