CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of BIRCH CREEK, a tributary of the UMATILLA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 17.5 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 396. The date of priority is JULY 28, 1910. The right is limited to not more than 0.22 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 33, T 2 N, R 32 E, W.M.; 335 FEET SOUTH AND 1129 FEET EAST FROM THE W 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 33.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 15.9 ACRES NW 1/4 SW 1/4 1.6 ACRES SECTION 33 TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 32 EAST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEBRUARY 12, 1953, and together with certificates 64211 and 64213, supersedes certificate 1032, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
