CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CHRIS PETERSON  
NORTH POWDER, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH POWDER RIVER, a tributary of POWDER RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 351.0 ACRES.

The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UNION County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 3, at page 252. The date of priority is 1889 FOR 30 ACRES, 1898 FOR 293 ACRES, AND 1904 FOR 28 ACRES.

The right is limited to not more than 8.78 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND FROM MARCH 1 TO JULY 1 AND 4.39 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND FROM JULY 1 TO OCTOBER 1 EACH YEAR.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

DAVIS-KELSEY DITCH - SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 35, T 6 S, R 38 E, W.M.  
AND ELLIS DITCH - NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 36, T 6 S, R 38 E, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 1503, Volume 2, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on SEPTEMBER 6, 1989 concluding cancellation proceeding PC 88-13.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
