CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CARL F. EHLIG 291 DOG CREEK ROAD SUNNY VALLEY, OREGON 97497-9715

confirms the right to use the waters of BRIMSTONE GULCH CREEK, LITTLE BRIMSTONE CREEK, AND EHLIG RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-5504, tributaries of GRAVE CREEK, for the purpose of FISH CULTURE AND IRRIGATING 5.95 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 34563. The date of priority is JULY 30, 1969 FOR 0.066 CFS FROM BRIMSTONE GULCH CREEK AND SEPTEMBER 22, 1969 FOR 0.03 CFS FROM LITTLE BRIMSTONE CREEK. The right is limited to not more than 0.096 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND; BEING 0.066 CFS for IRRIGATION from Brimstone Gulch Creek and 0.03 CFS for FISH CULTURE from Little Brimstone Creek & Reservoir or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 8, T 34 S, R 6 W,
W.M.; BRIMSTONE GULCH CREEK - 170 FEET SOUTH & 1300 FEET WEST; LITTLE
BRIMSTONE CREEK - 2530 FEET SOUTH & 1230 FEET WEST; BOTH FROM N 1/4
CORNER OF SECTION 8.

The amount of water used for irrigation shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4 5.95 ACRES SE 1/4 NW 1/4 FISH CULTURE SECTION 8

TOWNSHIP 34 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by certificate 45938, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered APRIL 18, 1990, approving transfer application 6034.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
