CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of POWDER RIVER, a tributary of SNAKE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 63.0 ACRES.

The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for BAKER County and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State Water Records in Volume 19, at page 70 that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1893.

The right is limited to not more than 1/40 OF ONE CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4 19 ACRES
SW 1/4 SW 1/4 28 ACRES
SE 1/4 SW 1/4 16 ACRES
SECTION 28
TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 45 EAST, W.M.

This certificate is issued so as to correctly describe the place of use and describes that portion of the water right confirmed by certificate 4111, State record of Water Right Certificates, as corrected by a decree and order of the Circuit Court for Baker County, entered September 27, 1989.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
