confirms the right to use the waters of JOHN'S SPRING, a tributary of the NORTH FORK MILL CREEK, for the purpose of LIVESTOCK AND WILDLIFE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 46458. The date of priority is APRIL 8, 1981. The right is limited to not more than 0.002 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 7, T 1 S, R 11 E, W.M.; 2640 FEET WEST FROM THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 7.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4  
SECTION 7  
TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
