The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for DOUGLAS County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 14, at page 202. The date of priority is 1901.

The right is limited to not more than 3.8 MINERS INCHES.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by orders of the Water Resources Director entered APRIL 29, 1980 AND JUNE 29, 1981, and together with certificate 51724, supersedes certificate 14554, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
