CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILLAMINA LUMBER COMPANY
9400 SW BARNES ROAD, SUITE 400
PORTLAND, OREGON 97225

confirms the right to use the waters of WILLAMINA CREEK, a tributary of SOUTH YAMHILL RIVER, for the purpose of MANUFACTURING AND FIRE PROTECTION.

The right has been perfected under Permit 44808. The date of priority is JANUARY 7, 1980. The right is limited to not more than 0.2 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.19 CFS FOR MANUFACTURING AND 0.01 CFS FOR FIRE PROTECTION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 38, SECTION 1, T 6 S, R 7 W, W.M.; 988 FEET SOUTH AND 1252 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER SECTION 1.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

LOT 1 (NE 1/4 NW 1/4)
SECTION 1
TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
