confirms the right to store the waters of BEAVER CREEK, a tributary of WILLAMETTE RIVER, appropriated under Permit 46758, for the purpose of IRRIGATION, RECREATION, AND LIVESTOCK.

The right to store these waters has been perfected under Reservoir Permit R-8439. The date of priority is MAY 28, 1982. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right is not more than 0.2 ACRE-FOOT; BEING 0.1 ACRE-FOOT FOR RECREATION, 0.09 ACRE-FOOT FOR IRRIGATION, AND 0.01 ACRE-FOOT FOR LIVESTOCK.

The reservoir is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4
NE 1/4 SW 1/4
SECTION 26
TOWNSHIP 3 SOUTH, RANGE 2 EAST, W.M.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
