CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of PAT O'SHEA CREEK, a tributary of the SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 8.6 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 47317. The date of priority is OCTOBER 4, 1982. The right is limited to not more than 0.073 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 2 (NW 1/4 NE 1/4), SECTION 27, T 30 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 765 FEET NORTH AND 135 FEET EAST FROM THE EASTERLY SE CORNER OF DLC 51.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4	0.2 ACRE
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 51	
LOT 3 (SW 1/4 NE 1/4)	3.7 ACRES
LOT 4 (SE 1/4 NE 1/4)	4.7 ACRES
SECTION 27	
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.	

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
