CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of the SANTIAM RIVER, a tributary of the WILLAMETTE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 63.8 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 47809. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 20, 1983. The right is limited to not more than 0.80 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 65, SECTION 2, T 10 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 700 FEET NORTH AND 1950 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 2.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4	1.0 ACRE
NE 1/4 SW 1/4	4.5 ACRES
NE 1/4 SE 1/4	9.2 ACRES
NW 1/4 SE 1/4	35.6 ACRES
SW 1/4 SE 1/4	7.3 ACRES
SE 1/4 SE 1/4	6.2 ACRES

ALL AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 65
SECTION 2
TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
