confirms the right to use the waters of ST. JOHN'S CREEK, a tributary of the SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 2.0 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 1836. The date of priority is DECEMBER 9, 1913. The right is limited to not more than 0.025 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 34, T 30 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 530 FEET SOUTH AND 1800 FEET WEST FROM THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 34.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4 2.0 ACRES SECTION 34 TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCTOBER 29, 1985, and together with certificate 57538, supersedes certificate 1971, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
