CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WESLEY D. PARKER 7371 NORTH APPLEGATE ROAD GRANTS PASS, OREGON 97527

confirms the right to use the waters of APPLEGATE RIVER, a tributary of ROGUE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 2.4 ACRES AND LIVESTOCK.

The right has been perfected under Permit 44761. The date of priority is JULY 2, 1979. The right is limited to not more than 0.035 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND; BEING 0.03 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.005 CFS FOR LIVESTOCK, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 20, T 37 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 700 FEET SOUTH AND 70 FEET EAST, 1120 FEET SOUTH AND 310 FEET WEST, BOTH FROM THE N 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 20.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4 2.4 ACRES AND LIVESTOCK SECTION 20 TOWNSHIP 37 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
