CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOSEPH S. DANCHOK
2241 CAVITT CREEK ROAD
GLIDE, OREGON 97443

confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING, a tributary of CAVITT CREEK, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF LAWN AND NON-COMMERCIAL GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 44642. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 11, 1979 FOR 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND AND JANUARY 28, 1980 FOR 0.005 CFS. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CFS or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 14, T 27 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 2300 FEET NORTH AND 1150 FEET WEST FROM THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 14.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4
SECTION 14
TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
