confirms the right to use the waters of KNEBAL SPRING, a tributary of the MIDDLE FORK FIVE MILE CREEK, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE IN A CAMPGROUND.

This right has been perfected under Permit 48737. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 13, 1983. This right is limited to 0.006 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 4 (SW 1/4 SW 1/4), SECTION 31, T 1 S, R 11 E, W.M.; 790 FEET NORTH AND 900 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 31.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

LOT 4 (SW 1/4 SW 1/4)
SECTION 31
TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
