CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of CALAPOOYA CREEK, a tributary of the UMPQUA RIVER, for the purpose of the IRRIGATION OF 10.0 ACRES AND DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY.

This right has been perfected under Permit 48415. The date of priority is MARCH 16, 1984. This right is limited to 0.080 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.075 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.005 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 51, SECTION 7, T 25 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 1520 FEET SOUTH AND 400 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 7.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4 10.0 ACRES AND DOMESTIC
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 47
SECTION 8
TOWNSHIP 25 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
