## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

UNITED STATES, UMPQUA NATIONAL FOREST P.O. BOX 1008 ROSEBURG, OREGON 97470

confirms the right to use the waters of the SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of the UMPQUA RIVER, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR SIX FAMILIES AND MAINTENANCE OF A FIRE PROTECTION SYSTEM.

This right has been perfected under Permit 49176. The date of priority is DECEMBER 5, 1984. This right is limited to 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND; BEING 0.01 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE AND 0.01 CFS FOR MAINTENANCE OF FIRE PROTECTION SYSTEM, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 33, T 30 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 1220 FEET SOUTH AND 1840 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 33.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4 FIRE

NE 1/4 NW 1/4 DOMESTIC AND FIRE

SECTION 33

TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
