CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of two SUMPS in the SKIPANON RIVER BASIN for the purpose of IRRIGATION, CHEMICAL APPLICATION, TEMPERATURE CONTROL AND FLOOD HARVESTING ON 7.5 ACRES OF CRANBERRIES.

The right has been perfected under Permit G-10045. The date of priority is MARCH 24, 1983. The right is limited to not more than 1.96 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND; BEING 0.19 CFS FOR IRRIGATION, 0.19 CFS FOR CHEMICAL APPLICATION, 1.13 CFS FOR TEMPERATURE CONTROL AND 1.96 CFS FOR FLOOD HARVESTING, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the sumps.

The sumps are located as follows:

LOT 2 (SW 1/4 NE 1/4), SECTION 27, T 7 N, R 10 W, W.M.; SUMP 1 - 170 FEET SOUTH AND 820 FEET WEST, SUMP 3 - 550 FEET SOUTH AND 350 FEET WEST, BOTH FROM THE NE CORNER OF LOT 2 (SW 1/4 NE 1/4) SECTION 27.

For irrigation of cranberries, this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. For irrigation of any other crop, this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

LOT 1 (NW 1/4 NE 1/4) 0.9 ACRE  
LOT 2 (SW 1/4 NE 1/4) 6.6 ACRES  
SECTION 27  
TOWNSHIP 7 NORTH, RANGE 10 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
