CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL 2 in the LONG TOM RIVER BASIN for the purpose of IRRIGATING 13.2 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit G-10147. The date of priority is AUGUST 8, 1983. The right is limited to not more than 0.17 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 42, SECTION 3, T 14 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 890 FEET SOUTH AND 2250 EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF DLC 69.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 4.8 ACRES
SW 1/4 SE 1/4 0.4 ACRE
SE 1/4 SE 1/4 8.0 ACRES
ALL AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 42
SECTION 3
TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
