confirms the right to store the waters of SQUAW GULCH, a tributary of SLATE CREEK, and SLATE CREEK, a tributary of the APPLGATE RIVER, appropriated under Permit 39590, for the purpose of IRRIGATION.

The right to store these waters was perfected under Reservoir Permit R-6340. The date of priority is JULY 1, 1975. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under this right is not more than 1.8 acre feet.

The reservoir is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4
SECTION 9
TOWNSHIP 37 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.

SLATE CREEK DIVERSION LOCATED:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 10, T 37 S, R 7 W, W.M.; 725 FEET NORTH AND 125 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 10.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
