CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JAMES W. AND DAVID A. BASSETT, P.E. 433 AND 500 WONDER LANE WILDERVILLE, OREGON 97543

confirms the right to use the waters of SQUAW GULCH AND A RESERVOIR, constructed under Permit R-6340, a tributary of SLATE CREEK, WITH ANY DEFICIENCY IN SUPPLY TO BE APPROPRIATED FROM SLATE CREEK, a tributary of the APPLEGATE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 5.3 ACRES.

This right has been perfected under Permit 39590. The date of priority is JULY 1, 1975. This right is limited to 0.07 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 9, SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 10, T 37 S, R 7 W, W.M.; SQUAW GULCH AND RESERVOIR - 945 FEET NORTH AND 150 FEET WEST FROM THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 9; SLATE CREEK - 725 FEET NORTH AND 125 FEET EAST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 9.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) from direct flow and 4.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated from direct flow and storage during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 0.3 ACRE
SE 1/4 NE 1/4 5.0 ACRES
SECTION 9
TOWNSHIP 37 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
