## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RICHARD DONALD BUTTS 21390 SW McINNIS LANE ALOHA, OREGON 97007

confirms the right to use the waters of BUTTERNUT CREEK, a tributary of TUALATIN RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 3.2 ACRES AND LIVESTOCK.

The right has been perfected under Permit 44801. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 20, 1979. The right is limited to not more than 0.045 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND; BEING 0.040 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.005 CFS FOR LIVESTOCK, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 1 (SW 1/4 NE 1/4), SECTION 14, T 1 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 330 FEET NORTH AND 250 FEET EAST FROM THE CENTER 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. Water shall not be appropriated under this right during the period of July 31 through September 15 of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

LOT 1 (SW 1/4 NE 1/4) 3.2 ACRES AND LIVESTOCK SECTION 14
TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
