confirms the right to use the waters of SALMON RIVER, a tributary of PACIFIC OCEAN, for the purpose of FISH REARING.

The right has been perfected under Permit 45000. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 5, 1980. The right is limited to not more than 16.5 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 29, T 6 S, R 10 W, W.M.; 75 FEET NORTH AND 290 FEET WEST FROM THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 29.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4 FISH REARING
SECTION 29
TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 10 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
