CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BLACK BUTTE RANCH ASSOCIATION

confirms the right to use the waters of INDIAN FORD CREEK AND PHALAROPE LAKE RESERVOIR, constructed under Permit R-8253, a tributary of SQUAW CREEK, for the purpose of RECREATION AND FISH HABITAT ENHANCEMENT.

The right has been perfected under Permit 45644. The date of priority is APRIL 14, 1980. The right is limited to not more than 0.05 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.025 CFS FOR EACH USE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 10, T 14 S, R 9 E, W.M.; 1380 FEET SOUTH AND 540 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 10.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4
SE 1/4 NE 1/4
SECTION 9

NW 1/4 NW 1/4
SW 1/4 NW 1/4
SECTION 10

TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 9 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
