CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of the APPLGATE RIVER, a tributary of the ROGUE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 2.4 ACRES.

The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 16, at page 523. The date of priority is 1902.

The right is limited to not more than 0.047 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 19, T 37 S, R 5 W, W.M.; MURPHY DITCH - SOUTH 20 DEGREES EAST, 780 FEET FROM THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19.

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 24, T 37 S, R 6 W, W.M.; APPLGATE RIVER - 170 FEET NORTH AND 1050 FEET WEST FROM THE CENTER 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 24.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4 NW 1/4      2.4 ACRES  
SECTION 24  
TOWNSHIP 37 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered APRIL 19, 1982, and together with certificate 50912, supersedes certificate 32860, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
