CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

W. B. and M. JEANNE REEVES
880 HUSKY ROAD
MOSIER, OREGON 97040

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the DRY CREEK BASIN for the purpose of SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 60 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-8865. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 13, 1979. The right is limited to 0.66 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 7, T 2 N, R 12 E, W.M.; 1300 FEET SOUTH AND 1000 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 7.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any other right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

The right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 34.5 ACRES
NW 1/4 NE 1/4 8.1 ACRES



TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 12 EAST, W.M.

An order of the Water Resources Director entered August 15, 1990 in Special Order Volume 44, Page 331 approved a request to diminish this water right from primary irrigation to supplemental irrigation of the same lands. This certificate is issued to supercede certificate 56175, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
