confirms the right to use the waters of LOST CREEK, a tributary of the MCKENZIE RIVER, in the WILLAMETTE RIVER BASIN to maintain an instream flow for the purpose of ANADROMOUS AND RESIDENT FISH HABITAT.

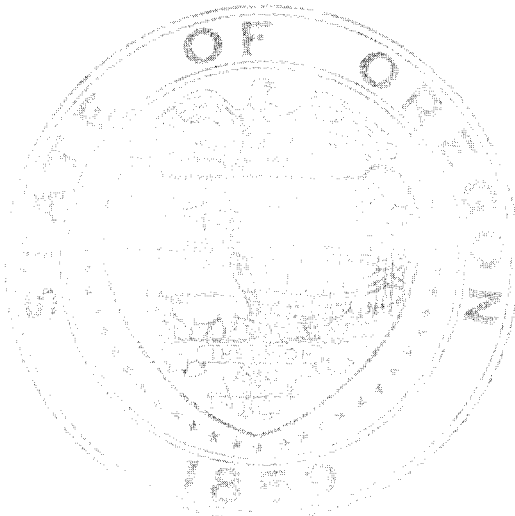
This right is for flows to be maintained in LOST CREEK FROM THE CONFLUENCE WITH WHITE BRANCH AT RIVER MILE 3.4 (NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 24, T 16 S. R 6 E, W.M.); TO THE MOUTH OF LOST CREEK AT RIVER MILE 0.0 (NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 10, T 16 S, R 6 E, W.M.).

This right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.341.

The date of priority is JULY 16, 1990.

This right is limited to the amounts during the time periods listed below:

OCTOBER 1 - MAY 31	150
JUNE 1 - AUGUST 30	100
SEPTEMBER 1 - SEPTEMBER 30	150
