CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

EUGENE L. ROSE

confirms the right to use the waters of an UNNAMED SLOUGH, a tributary of the NORTH SANTIAM RIVER, for the purpose of the SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 33.6 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 26066. The date of priority is MARCH 16, 1959. The right is limited to not more than 0.42 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 2 (NW 1/4 SE 1/4), SECTION 5, T 10 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 2173 FEET SOUTH AND 412 FEET EAST FROM THE NE CORNER OF DLC 57.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The right shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change from PRIMARY IRRIGATION TO SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JULY 18, 1990 and supersedes certificate 39850, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
