CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of the WALLOWA RIVER, a tributary of GRANDE RONDE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 14.0 ACRES.

This right has been perfected under Permit 39074. The date of priority is MAY 14, 1974. This right is limited to 0.12 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 5 (NW 1/4 NW 1/4), SECTION 5, T 3 S, R 45 E, W.M.;
SOUTH 77 DEGREES 20 MINUTES EAST, 624 FEET FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 5.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4 14.0 ACRES
SECTION 32
TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 45 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
