CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of DUTCHER CREEK, a tributary of ROGUE RIVER, for the purpose of TEMPERATURE CONTROL ON 11.0 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 46647. The date of priority is OCTOBER 19, 1981. The right is limited to not more than 1.52 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND; BEING 0.51 CFS DURING FEBRUARY AND MARCH FOR PRECOOLING OF BUDS AND 1.52 CFS DURING APRIL AND MAY FOR FROST PROTECTION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 16, T 36 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 1350 FEET SOUTH AND 650 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 16.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4 11.0 ACRES
SECTION 16
TOWNSHIP 36 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
